

We Are Not on the Brink of WW-III

Recent news would lead you to believe that we are on the brink of World War 3 (WW3). This comes on the heels of conflict between Iran, other Middle East countries and terrorist organizations, and Israel. This narrative is totally FALSE. The reality is that we have been fighting WW-3 since the beginning of the Cold War.

Often during war, coalitions or alliances between countries are formed to attack or defend other countries. During WW2 there were the **Axis powers** and the **Allied powers**. Such alliances are based on shared ideologies and goals.

Following WW2, a new war broke out (Cold War), and the composition of the former two coalitions were reformed and renamed with a new third element added to the revised alliances – **geopolitics**. During the **Cold War**, the US with its allies formed the **Western Bloc** alliance while the Soviet Union and its allies formed the **Eastern Bloc**. After 44 years the Cold War ended in 1991. Although there was no direct confrontation between the Western and Eastern Bloc countries, each side used “proxies” to do any required attacks. The Cold War is classified as a proxy war.

Proxy War: a war fought between groups or smaller countries that each represent the interests of other larger powers, and may have help and support from these [powers].

Although the Cold War ended with the downfall of the USSR, the unification of East and West Germany, and the destruction of the Berlin Wall, there remained strong hatred between ideological groups.

A year after the Cold War started (1948) the modern state of Israel was created. The recognition of Israel as a nation extended what was once a set of religious based alliances into a complex and evolving web of alliances and conflict. The two broad category alliances are the pro-Israeli alliance and the anti-Israeli alliance.
